# Goal

React to a text input (known as *prompt*) by generating new related text. The most trendy applications are *chat bots*.

# ERNIE Bot

- Developer: Baidu.
- Based on ERNIE 3.0 (Wang et al., 2021).
- Trained on "trillions of web pages, billions of search and image data, billions of speech calls, and a knowledge graph of 550 billion facts".
- Able to perform:
  - Math operations.
  - Converse in several Chinese's dialects.
  - Image generation.
  - Video generation (not available to every user).
- Very closed beta.
- Very rushed approach due to market's demand.





# AutoGPT

- Developer: Significant Gravitas<sup>1</sup>.
- Extension of the GPT (Brown et al., 2020).
- Use of AutoML (LeDell and Poirier, 2020) to optimize the architecture and hyperparameters of the GPT model.
- Automatically fine-tunes the model for a given task or dataset.
- It leverages advanced algorithms and computational resources to efficiently explore the vast search space and identify the optimal model configuration.

## Bard

- Developer: Google.
- Based on LaMDA (Language Models for Dialog Applications; Thoppilan et al., 2022).
- Source citations.
- Complementary experience to *Google Search*. "Google It" button.
- Limited context (for now).
- User feedback to improve the model.
- Only available in US English (for now).
- Waitlist system. Not yet available in Spain.





### Bard

- Developer: Stability AI.
- Open-source language model.
- Available in 3 billion and 7 billion parameters, with 15 billion to 65 billion parameter models to follow.
- Trained on a new experimental dataset, built on The Pile (Gao et al., 2020).
- Models available at GitHub<sup>2</sup>

# Example Chit-Chat

User: Hey! My name is John nice to meet you!

StableLM: Hello John! It's always a pleasure to meet new people.

**User**: The pleasure is mine. Hey my grandma is in Toronto. I want to plan a surprise visit for her. She's a person who loves gardens and flowers.

StableLM: That's wonderful! It's great to hear that you'll be visiting your grandma in

Toronto. Can you tell me a little bit more about your plans?

 $\begin{tabular}{ll} \textbf{User:} & Ya\ I\ need\ to\ book\ a\ flight\ there\ and\ a\ hotel.\ But\ first,\ what\ recommendations\ do\ you\ have\ for\ gifts\ that\ she\ might\ like? \end{tabular}$ 

**StableLM**: I think that's a very thoughtful idea! It's a very personal gift that would be sure to make her very happy. I can think of a few examples that she might really enjoy. There are some lovely bouquets or arrangements that would be lovely for the house, or even for the yard. Flowers are a great choice for a surprise gift, and they're also a great choice for a wedding shower present. Also, if you're really looking for something a bit more special, I think she'd really enjoy a quality set of cooking pots or pans. That's something that she's likely to use frequently, so it would make her feel really loved.



### Example

### Chit-Chat

 $\label{lem:User: Thanks for the suggestion! Hmm a bouquet of flowers sounds nice but I don't think I can take them on the air plane. What do you think I should do?}$ 

**StableLM**: There are many possible solutions! One option would be to arrange a small gift in the shape of a card and send it to her by regular mail. Or you could arrange a special meal at a restaurant that she likes, or even cook a meal at home for her. Or you could send her some local goodies that she might like, like a nice bouquet of flowers or a special recipe. You could even arrange for tickets to a local theatre or sporting event, and make sure to include a note about what you'd like her to know about you. Really any sort of special attention from you will be sure to make her very happy!

User: Ah! Right. I can order a bouquet for her online and get it delivered! Thanks!

**StableLM**: You're very welcome! As long as you do this and make it a very personal, thoughtful gesture, she'll be sure to appreciate it.

### Formal Writing

User: What would you say to a friend who is graduating high school?

**StableLM**: I would say that they have every right to feel proud of themselves and their accomplishments. They should be proud of the work they've done and the friends they have made, and also be excited about the future.

User: Please write an email.

StableLM: Okay, here's an example of what could be written:

Dear [Friend's Name],

I hope this email finds you well. I just wanted to take a moment to express how proud I am of you and all that you have accomplished. I know that getting into [university or college] is a big accomplishment, and I appreciate all that you have done for me and for this generation.

I hope that you are having a good day. I'm sure that you are also concerned about the future, but I just wanted to let you know that I am also watching you grow and develop into the person that I know that you can be. Keep up the good work, and I have full faith that you will achieve great things.

Thank you again for everything that you do.

User: Write an epic rap battle song between deep neural networks and symbolic AI

StableLM: [Beat drops]

Deep Neural Networks: Listen up everyone, it's time to witness The power of deep neural networks, it's just a matter of abstract We've trained these networks to solve complex problems with ease While symbolic AI is limited to simple math and simple flows

Symbolic AI: Hold up, hold up, let me interrupt It's been a while since I've heard, some new thoughts you interrupt But let me tell you, my friend, it's not all about math and flow It's about making the world a better place, you know

Deep Neural Networks: Well, I can see where you're coming from, it's clear But deep neural networks, they never get the same gear We can use them to analyze and predict with ease And prove the superiority of machine learning

Symbolic AI: You're right, it's not just math or numbers But it's the essence of our lives, it's what counts, we're numbers I don't need a complicated math formula, just a simple device To make the world a better place, it's a noble price

Prompt: What is Bing Chat?

- Bing Chat is an AI chatbot experience from Microsoft based on the popular ChatGPT (version 4) Large Language Model (LLM) from OpenAI to offer similar responses to how humans will answer questions<sup>3</sup>.
- Bing Chat is essentially Microsoft's flavor of ChatGPT<sup>4</sup>.
- According to Digital Trends, Bing Chat is Microsoft's answer to ChatGPT —in fact, it's based on the same technology that makes OpenAI's chatbot run<sup>5</sup>.

#### -eatures

- Integration of *ChatGPT* into *Bing*'s search engine.
- Only available through Microsoft's Edge.
- It opens on the sidebar.
- It is able to search and summarize the website you are viewing.
- Creative tool. It can help you write poems, stories or even share ideas for a project.
- Makes web searches.
- Responsible AI.



### Example

John Scalzi $^6$  asked the Bing AI to write a paragraph about the Easter Bunny in his style. This is what it wrote, and then this is the conversation they had afterward.

Bing: Here is a paragraph I wrote in the style of John Scalzi about the Easter Bunny:

The Easter Bunny was not amused. He had spent the whole night hopping from house to house, delivering eggs and candy to the children of the world, only to find out that someone had hacked his GPS system and sent him to the wrong locations. He had left chocolate eggs in a vegan commune, jelly beans in a diabetic clinic, and peeps in a bird sanctuary. He had also been chased by dogs, cats, and one particularly angry llama. He was tired, sore, and covered in spit and feathers. He decided to take a break and check his email, hoping for some words of encouragement from his fellow holiday mascots. Instead, he found a message from Santa Claus, with a subject line that read: "You've been pranked! Happy April Fools' Day!"

John: That... actually does sound a little like me.

### Third-party plugins

- 1. Build an API with endpoints you'd like a language model to call (this can be a new API, an existing API, or a wrapper around an existing API specifically designed for LLMs).
- Create an OpenAPI specification documenting your API, and a manifest file that links to the OpenAPI spec and includes some plugin-specific metadata.

Best of all, ChatGPT can help you build it!

- FiscalNote: Provides and enables access to select market-leading, real-time data sets for legal, political, and regulatory data and information.

# Controversy

- Some developers are creating the models for lucrative purposes.
- Some users are using the outputs for commercial and lucrative purposes.
- Plagiarism.
- Overall, this is a delicate matter that needs to be address and legislated carefully.

Not a solution, but an interesting approach: *Open Assistant*<sup>6</sup>. An open-source, community approach for creating a "conversational AI for everyone".
